The project also conducts follow-up inside activities to encourage health in the home and a balanced diet for the children of the participating families; likewise, we have been executing the business management advice to mothers who are starting up or trying to improve their own business.



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PROJECT YACHAY VIII

During the month of October the courses of Basic Cooking, Pastry Basic, Housekeeping, Electrical Installations, Catering and event management ended. These courses are a part of the first phase of training and job placement of Project YACHAY VIII. The number of students graduating from their courses this month is 47, and 25 students more who followed their course outside of the institute (e.g. in Písaq, Peruvian Cuisine San Jerónimo), constituting a total of 72 students trained during the first phase of the project.



Likewise, it is noteworthy that during the October two new courses were installed, Handling of Food and Floristry, together with the Municipality of Santiago, which is also involved in the courses of Peruvian Cuisine and Housekeeping in Oropesa.
